Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How do I sign up for the league?

A: Registering your daughter for our league is done online. Simply follow the links on our home page and be sure to read the instructions. Registration is open from the middle of October through the beginning of January. Late registration usually continues through the middle of February, if there is space available on teams. Check the league calendar for the exact dates for this year.

Q: How does walk-in registration differ from online registration?

A: There is no difference. Walk-in registration is for those individuals who do not have access to their own computer. We will have computers set up for your use to register online.

Q: My daughter has no experience playing softball. Is this league too competitive for her?

A: Absolutely not. This is a recreational league for girls between 4.5 and 16 years old and of all experience levels.

Q: Which division will my daughter be in?

A: The division of play is determined by her age on January 1st of the upcoming year. Her age at that time will be her league age for the current season.

Age 4.5 -6 = 6U Division (Bobby Sox)

Age 7-8 = 8U Division (Rookies)

Age 9-10 = 10U Division (Mini-Minors)

Age 11-12 = 12U Division (Minors)

Age 13-16 = 16U Division (Majors)

Q: What if I want my daughter to play in a higher division?

A: First, register your daughter in the division she would normally play in. For example, if she would normally play in the 6U division, but you would like her to play in the 8U division, register her in 6U to begin with. Anyone requesting to play in a higher age division must fill out the request to play up form located under home and downloads.

Q: My daughter wants to play with a specific friend or coach, can I request that?

A: Friend requests are possible in the 6U and 8U divisions. You may make a coach request at all divisions at the time of registration. The Board does its best to honor such requests, but not all requests can be guaranteed.

Q: When will my daughter be notified as to which team she is on and when does the season begin?

A: Teams are formed in the beginning of February and practice starts the beginning of March. Players are notified by their coach or manager soon after the teams are formed (The week of the February 20th). Opening day games are March 31st. There are typically two games per week: one on a weekday evening and one on Saturday.

Q: What equipment do we need to provide for my daughter to play softball?

A: She will need her own glove and cleats. The league provides bats, balls, helmets, catcher's equipment, etc. The registration cost covers the cost of uniform shirt and visor. Individual teams decide on color and style of socks usually within the first weeks of practice. These will need to be purchased by the parents.

Q: What are my obligations as a parent to the league?

A: The parent(s) of each player is expected to volunteer three hours during the season. The league also welcomes active participation and is always looking for enthusiastic volunteers.

Q: How do I become a coach, manager or umpire?

A: Go to the 'Volunteer' tab on the home page of the website and enroll. The website will guide you through the process.

Q: What happens if I register my daughter and then we have to cancel?

A: You can receive a refund minus a \$30 processing fee if we are notified that she is dropping out before February 4th. No refunds will be issued after that.
